Product Release Notes

Dear GreenRoad Customer,

We are excited to announce the latest GreenRoad release.

In general, our product releases introduce new features across all of our products: the GreenRoad Drive[™] app, GreenRoad Central[™] and GreenRoad Edge[™]. However, to give you maximum control, we wait to activate some of the new features for your fleet until you are ready, and you won't "see" them until you instruct us to "power them up."

In this document we will specify which new features are automatically activated for everyone, and which are activated only upon your request.

Our latest release incorporates the following new features:

- Enabling managers to send messages to Drive[™] App users this is an extremely useful feature that creates a new communications channel between your managers and their drivers.
- "Live" Idling Alert (Edge[™] only) your managers can now receive a real-time alert when a driver has been idling longer than the allowed time.
- New dashboard widgets for camera-based safety events (for VideoSense Pro[™] users) see which risky Road-Facing and Driver-Facing events are most challenging for your drivers, with one-click drill-down into driver and trip details.
- Management of lost Dallas Keys define a grace period during which your drivers can continue to search for lost keys (maybe they will be magically found?) and after which they will be deleted and no longer associated with a driver.

How can you start benefiting from these new functionalities

For the Drive[™] App: make sure that all your drivers download the latest version of the Drive[™] App (8.1) For all other new features: ask your Account Manager to activate the ones you want to "power up" for your organization.



Enabling managers to send messages to Drive™ App users

Establish a new communication channel between managers and their drivers.

With this new functionally, your managers will be able to send notifications (e.g. reminders or crucial information) directly to their drivers from Central[™]. This is a great tool that you can use to improve fleet collaboration, efficiency, and, most importantly, safety.

To get you started, we have loaded the system with a default message that you can use to remind drivers to set their Duty Mode to 'On Duty' during work hours. We invite you to add in additional new messages that serve your fleet's unique requirements and operations by contacting your Account Manager or sending a request to Support. In the future, we will enable you to independently add messages via Central[™]. *Note: no messages added for your fleet will be shared with other customers.*

Idling Events - New Real-Time Alert

Cutting down on idling is one of the most effective ways for managers to trim their fleet operating expenses and reduce their emissions. GreenRoad has always provided managers with useful tools for the effort, including insightful data about the historical idling behaviors of each driver and vehicle.



As of this release now, we're taking these capabilities to the next level, enabling managers to be sent **real-time alerts** about idling that is currently underway. These alerts are sent automatically when a driver or vehicle has been idling for longer than a (configurable) time limit, enabling them to take immediate action. Over time, this can make a significant impact on the fleet's idling rates, helping reduce fuel expenses and emissions.

New dashboard widgets for camera-based safety events (for VideoSense Pro[™] users)


We are excited to launch two powerful new dashboard widgets that make it easy to stay on top of safety issues identified by in-cab cameras:

- The **Driver-Facing Events** widget shows how many **compliance** and **drowsiness** events have been recorded recently on your fleet's cameras, with a pie-chart breakdown of Seatbelt, Phone Usage, Smoking, Distraction, Yawning and Fatigue events.
- The Road-Facing Events widget shows how many ADAS (Advanced Driver-Assistance System) events have been recorded recently on your fleet cameras, with a pie-chart breakdown of FCW (Forward Collision Warning), LDW (Lane Departure Warning) and HMW (Headway Monitoring Warning) events.

A click on a pie-chart segment displays the number of events recorded for that category, and another click displays a list of each event, including the driver and vehicle involved, trip details and a link to a video of the event.

Note: these widgets are available only to fleets that have installed AI cameras with the GreenRoad VideoSense Pro[™]. To activate them, please contact your Account Manager.





Management of lost Dallas Keys

We have changed the Dallas Key management process in order to provide a "grace period" during which drivers may still find keys that they previously reported as lost.

If this feature is activated, from the moment a Dallas Key is officially deleted, it is not deleted permanently for x days (the number of days that you specify). Deleted keys actually remain listed in the database, but are no longer displayed in Central[™].

Note: To activate this feature, please contact your Account Manager. Please note that it requires a firmware update as well.
